STEP #1: APPLY FOR THE MISSION TRIP BEFORE SUNDAY, DECEMBER 18

Students must submit a \$100 non-refundable deposit with the bottom portion of this application, including a photocopy of a current passport. STUDENTS MAY NOT APPLY WITHOUT A CURRENT PASSPORT.*

STEP #2: ATTEND INTERNATIONAL MISSION TRIP MTG AT 5:15 pm ON SUNDAY, DECEMBER 4

Our initial team meeting will clarify the dates and final details of the trip so that both parents and students will have six months to prepare for this intensive mission trip.

STEP #3: PARTNER WITH OTHERS TO PREPARE FOR YOUR MISSION TRIP

POSSIBLE TRIP DATES

IF LESS THAN 12 SHOUT STUDENTS APPLY BY DECEMBER 18:

Our trip will be included with GAIN's trip planned for July 7-14, and we will join other groups traveling to Haiti.

IF OVER 12 SHOUT STUDENTS APPLY BY DECEMBER 18:

Our trip will include only students and adults from SHOUT on either:

Saturday, June 30 - Saturday, July 7 (first choice)

OR Saturday, July 28 - Saturday, August 4 (second choice)

TRIP COST

This cost covers flight, housing, ministry, and Mission Trip T-shirt. SHOUT will partner with students and families so that a portion of the profits from the Yard Sale and all MISSION STOCK sold by students can significantly reduce this cost.

DETAILS ABOUT HAITI

HAITI: High School INTERNATIONAL TRIP

Haiti is the poorest country in the Western Hemisphere. It has been plagued by numerous disasters, civil unrest, and spiritual darkness for many years. The earthquake in January 2010 has opened the door for a renewed spiritual awakening and establishment of life-changing opportunities for the people of Haiti.

HOUSING DETAILS

The team will fly into Port-Au-Prince and will be transported to Chambrun, about 18 miles from the Port-Au-Prince airport. The team will minister in various areas in and around Chambrun, including local churches in the area, by distributing aid and working on possible construction projects. This trip is for those who can withstand very warm temperatures and high humidity. However, the team will stay in air-conditioned dorm style sleeping quarters in the Nehemiah Vision Ministries compound, and meals will be served in the compound kitchen.

HOW CAN ADULTS AND PARENTS GO ON A MISSION TRIP?

Trip Chaperones: SHOUT is looking for 2 to 3 adults with extensive experience in serving youth to support our on-site activities (*sleeping quarters, evening activities, SHOUT Group gatherings, etc.*) while also volunteering at the worksite during the day.

HOW DO I FUNRDAISE?

Stock Sales: You will receive official stock certificates, a record sheet, and a letter with more detailed instructions after you turn in your registration form. Then you will ask people, through personal contact and letters, to invest in YOU and the work that God has called you to this summer. You may also sign up to sell stock at Hempfield UMC one Sunday in between services. Once someone buys stock from you, they become an official stockholder in our Summer 2012 Mission Trips. They will receive a thank you letter from you during your trip and will be our guests at our Mission Sunday service that we will lead in August. We also encourage you to ask these sponsors to be in prayer for you throughout your preparation and week of service.

****HUMC Yard Sale:** ALL Mission Trip participants are expected to help with the Yard Sale on March 17, 2012 and/or in the days preceding the sale. Proceeds of the sale help reduce the cost of everyone's trip, and the cost of this trip may be further reduced pending the results of the Yard Sale.

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION IS DECEMBER 18, 2011

*Students must present a valid passport at time of application. Proof that a passport has been applied for will also be accepted.
