SUNDAY NITE SHOUT (SNS) VOLUNTEERS

_____ **Welcome Center Host/Hostess:** Provide a warm welcome to **high school** youth as they arrive; help them to sign in/sign out; help new youth connect with a leader and be "information central". Shifts are from 5:45-7:00 & 7:00-8:15 PM.

_____ **Chaperone:** Help keep a safe and caring environment in the youth areas at Sunday Nite SHOUT. These volunteers will be assigned to a specific area and will mingle with youth there, assuring that all youth are welcomed. They will also help to tear down Rooms 170 & 172. Shift is from 5:45-6:45 PM.

_____ **Food Coordinator:** Plan menu and purchase snacks for SNS. Set up, prepare, serve, and clean up SNS snacks. Shift is from about 5:15 or 5:30pm-6:45pm approximately once per month.

_____ **Food/Snacks Volunteer:** Work with Food Coordinator to set up, serve, and clean up snacks that are provided at Sunday Nite SHOUT. Shift is from 5:30-6:45PM.

_____ **Mid-Week SHOUT Helper:** Assist at this Wednesday night event (6-8pm) by being present to help us fulfill our Safe Sanctuary guidelines.

SHOUT GROUP LEADERS

_____ **SMS Leader:** Help with the supervision and facilitation of the **middle school** program, including setup and tear down, hanging out with students, sitting with the youth during the worship and lesson, and overseeing a group during "breakout" times. Leaders are asked to commit to two Sunday mornings per month from 9:30 AM no later than 11:30 AM.

_____ **SNS Leader:** Leaders' responsibilities are twofold: First, they are a visible, consistent group of adult leaders who "hang out," interact, and build relationships with the **high school** youth at SNS. This group helps to provide supervision throughout the night and participates in worship with the youth. Second, SHOUT Leaders facilitate a meeting with a small group of youth each Sunday night following SNS worship.

OTHER TEAMS/SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES

_____ **30 Hour Famine Planning Team:** Provide organization and support for the 30 Hour Famine, which takes place Feb. 3-4, 2012. Responsibilities may include helping with publicity, fundraising ideas, planning service projects, arranging for speakers, planning activities, or helping develop the closing worship.

_____ **Office Volunteer:** Provide occasional administrative support to SHOUT Youth Ministry. Tasks may include preparing mailings, making copies of youth ministry related materials, entering data into the computer and more.

_____ **Trip/Special Event Chaperone:** Attend a SHOUT trip or event, providing supervision, chaperoning, and other help as needed.
